

## Grade 12 French Curriculum

<b>FRENCH</b>	
<b>Themes</b>	<b>Students will be able to:</b>
<b>Construction of an apartment building</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- create different types of characters</li> <li>- create an apartment building</li> <li>- create telephone conversations</li> </ul>
<b>Decoration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- describe an apartment building (entrance, garden, different floors)</li> <li>- describe rooms</li> <li>- make a poster</li> </ul>
<b>Facsimilies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- communicate with different types of writing :</li> <li>- prepare placards</li> <li>- create rules</li> <li>- produce classified ads</li> <li>- invent graffiti</li> <li>- write personal messages</li> <li>- create announcements (births, weddings, deaths...)</li> </ul>
<b>Role-playing</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Act in scenes (talk about weather, express feelings, gossip in the stairway)</li> <li>- ask for small favours</li> <li>- conduct an investigation (imagine a dialogue between a detective and the superintendent of the apartment building in the form of a comic book)</li> <li>- imagine telephone conversations (jokes, ...)</li> <li>- predict the future and give advice</li> <li>- explain cooking recipes (a recipe from their country, imaginary recipes)</li> </ul>
<b>Novel</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- write a portrait (physical appearance, clothes, the impression someone makes, their tastes, their behaviour ...)</li> <li>- describe what people do in their apartment</li> <li>- write a biography / tell the story and the adventures of a character (where they come from, how they came to France, why...)</li> <li>- describe in detail a room (the caprice and the tastes of the tenant)</li> <li>- tell memories (write a memoir in diary form)</li> </ul>
